The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

#### **COUNT I**

Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Sale - Narcotic

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: Up to 20 years in prison and/or a find of up to \$250,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/01/2017

Control #(ICR#): 17007265

Charge Description: On or about December 1, 2017, in the county of Rice, State of Minnesota, Margaret Ann Ervin did possess with the intent to distribute one or more mixtures of a narcotic drug.

#### **COUNT II**

Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Possess 50 or More Dosages Narcotic Mixture

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.2(a)(3)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years or \$250,000, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/01/2017

Control #(ICR#): 17007265

Charge Description: On or about December 1, 2017, in the county of Rice, State of Minnesota, Margaret Ann Ervin did unlawfully possess a narcotic drug packaged in 50 or more dosage units.

#### **COUNT III**

Charge: Bring/Send/Introduce/Possess Contraband-State Prison/Hospital

Minnesota Statute: 243.55.1

Maximum Sentence: Up to 10 years in prison

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/01/2017

Control #(ICR#): 17007265

Charge Description: On or about December 1, 2017, in the County of Rice, Minnesota, Margaret Ann Ervin did bring, send or introduce controlled substances into a Minnesota Correctional Facility.

#### STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

The Complainant states	that the following facts establish probable cause:

In late November 2017, the investigations unit at the Minnesota Correctional Facility Faribault (MCF-FBO) received information that an Offender known as "St. Louis" was involved in smuggling opiates in through the visiting room. Jermaine Ervin (DOB 12/2/1980) was known to use that name.

On November 30, Jermaine Ervin placed calls in which he stated to the female on the other end of the call "this turn up is going to be fucking real." Jermaine Ervin also stated "you know how to be prepared right?" Later in the conversation Jermaine Ervin said "have that 2 ring cut." In a later call, Jermaine Ervin asked when she was leaving in the morning, she said 8:00.

On December 1, at 7:15 a.m. Jermaine Ervin called the same number again and asked if there was anything to do before she left, the female on the phone responded everything was packed up. At 3:44 p.m. Jermaine Ervin called again and asked what happened, the female responded, "I brought 18 dollars worth a... diapers." Jermaine Ervin responded "just take 6 dollars with you." Later Jermaine Ervin said to "Bring 2 dollars every day for some pictures" and "that other 12, you know, just, you know what I am saying."

The phone number called by Jermaine Ervin was determined to belong to his wife, Margaret Ann Ervin (DOB 8/24/1973). At 5:19 p.m. on December 1, 2017, Margaret Ervin was met by MCF-FBO investigators after she arrived and registered for a visit. Margaret Ervin was told that she was believed to be bringing contraband pills into the prison, Margaret Ervin said she was only thinking about it, but she had 12 blue pills in a knotted plastic bag in her front pants pocket, she identified those items as 30 mg pills of Oxycodone which she stated she took for her knee.

Margaret Ervin was interviewed by the Faribault Police Department and denied possession of any other drugs, she signed a written consent form agreeing to search of her rental car and her hotel room at the Grandstay in Faribault. During the search officers found an additional 242 pills identified on Drugs.com as 30 mg Oxycodone. Margaret Ervin stated the 12 pills she brought to the prison were a gift for Jermaine Ervin for his birthday and that all the pills had belonged to her late mother and had been prescribed to her.

#### SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or

(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.
