The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

#### COUNTI

Charge: Felony 5th Degree Controlled Substance- Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000 fine

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 07/10/2018

Control #(ICR#): 18002751

Charge Description: On or about July 10, 2018, in Rice County, Minnesota, Dustin Anderson did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a schedule II controlled substance, to wit: methamphetamine, with a total weight of .25 grams or more.

#### STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

The Complainant states that the following facts establish probable cause:	

Complainant and/or Signing Officer designated below, declares under penalty of perjury, that he/she has reviewed police reports relating to the above-named Defendant and the allegations contained herein, and/or has spoken with peace officers having knowledge of the incident, and based upon that information, believes the following to be true and correct.

On or about July 10, 2018, officers from the Faribault Police Department were dispatched to a suspicious person near 1910 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave NW in the City of Faribault. Dispatch advised that a male showed up at a residence and was possibly on drugs. The male actually walked up to the front door of the residence and rang the doorbell. Dispatch further advised that the male was carrying a baseball bat and umbrella and was pacing in the area. The male stated to the reporter that he was looking to take someone to rehab for methamphetamine use. Dispatch provided a description of the male as being a white male with a leather jacket, bald and wearing blue jeans.

An officer arrived in the area and saw a male standing near the side door of 1906 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave NW. The male matched the description and had a baseball bat in his hand. The officer made contact with the male, later identified as Dustin John Anderson, DOB: 02/01/1989 (hereinafter the defendant). The defendant's jacket was unzipped and the officer could see several metal objects sticking out from the inside pockets. The officer ordered the defendant to drop the baseball bat and umbrella. The male initially refused. The male eventually dropped the items he was holding but still refused to listen to commands for him to lay on the ground. Instead, the defendant took off his jacket before finally lying face down on the ground. The defendant also had a long, curved, metal object that came to a point like a blade in his possession.

Officer located a pill bottle in the defendant's front breast pocket of his shirt. The pill bottle had the defendant's name on it and contained two small baggies. One of the baggies contained a white crystal like substance that appeared to be methamphetamine. The other baggie contained several round, white pills with the imprint "14" on them. The officer also located a pack of cigarettes inside the defendant's jacket pocket. Inside the pack were five small, clear plastic gem baggies that each contained the same white crystal substance, which also appeared to be methamphetamine.

The baggies were all weighed. The total weight for all of the suspected methamphetamine with packaging was 7.52 grams.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE:** Pursuant to Minn. Stat. 609.49., intentional failure to appear for duly scheduled court appearances may result in additional criminal charges, and in addition to any arrest warrant that may otherwise be issued by the Court.
