## Press Release Assistance of Identification of Burglary Suspect December 14, 2018

The Northfield Police Department is seeking assistance in identifying a suspect involved in a recent burglary at Cake Walk.

On Thursday December 6<sup>th</sup> Northfield Officers responded to Cake Walk bakery in response to a burglary that had taken place at approximately 11:50 p.m. the previous night.
