PRESS RELEASE January 15, 2019

Armed Robbery





At approximately 11:50 a.m. on January 15, 2019, two male suspects entered the Premier Bank at 112 5th St E. in Northfield, Minnesota. One suspect approached a bank teller, displayed a black semi-automatic handgun and demanded money. They exited the bank on foot with an undisclosed amount of money.

The suspects are described as:

Black male, 30's, approximately 6'0", heavy set build, wearing a black beanie type hat, black scarf over face, teal winter jacket, black sleeves with purple squares on shoulders, grey sweatpants, whitish/grey gloves, and a high visibility yellow traffic type vest. This suspect displayed a black semi-automatic handgun.

Black male, late teens-early 20's, approximately 6'0", thin build, black stocking cap that covered face, yellow/black safety jacket with reflective striping, black pants, black gloves, and wearing a dark solid colored back pack. This suspect also believed to have possessed a firearm, but a good description of the weapon was not available.

Northfield Police Department is asking for any information on the identity of these suspects or any other information regarding this incident.
