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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Sale - Narcotic**

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.1(1), with reference to: 152.023.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: up to 20 years prison, or \$250,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 01/22/2019

Control #(ICR#): 19000278

Charge Description: On or about January 22, 2019, in Rice County, Minnesota, Jeremy Hagen did unlawfully sell one or more mixtures containing a schedule I narcotic, to wit: heroin.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

The Complainant states that the following facts establish probable cause:

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Complainant and/or Signing Officer designated below, declares under penalty of perjury, that he/she has reviewed police reports relating to the above-named Defendant and the allegations contained herein, and/or has spoken with peace officers having knowledge of the incident, and based upon that information, believes the following to be true and correct.

On or about January 22, 2019, agents from the Cannon River Drug and Violent Offender Task Force were contacted by a Confidential Reliable Source (CRS). The CRS said Jeremy Jacob Hagen, DOB: 11/28/1981, offered to sell a quantity of heroin for \$100.00. Hagen arranged the deal to take place in the City of Faribault.

Agents met with the CRS. Agents provided the CRS with \$100.00 of pre-recorded government buy money to purchase the heroin. An agent drove the CRS to the meet location. Hagen arrived to the location in a vehicle being driven by Kristin Marie Westerman, DOB: 11/03/1982. Westerman stopped the vehicle and got out. Hagen then got into the driver seat. The CRS entered the passenger seat. Westerman remained in the parking lot. Hagen drove the vehicle around the parking lot for approximately 30 seconds. During that time, the CRS gave Hagen the pre-recorded government buy money and Hagen gave the CRS the suspected Heroin. Hagen warned the CRS, "it's good shit so be careful." The CRS exited the vehicle and returned to the undercover vehicle. The CRS immediately gave the suspected heroin to the accompanying agent. Westerman got back into the driver seat and Hagen got back into the passenger seat. Westerman then drove the vehicle out of the parking lot.

It was apparent that Westerman knew what was going on as she got out of the vehicle. Westerman waited approximately 30 seconds in the freezing temperature while Hagen drove around the parking lot completing the deal. Westerman then returned to the driver seat and Hagen back to passenger seat. The vehicle was registered to Kristin Westerman. When the CRS entered the vehicle, Hagen could be heard telling Westerman that he was going to drop the CRS off at the front.

The suspected heroin tested positive and weighed .57 grams.
