56-year-old Cindy Mueske was traveling on Highway 52 near Chatfield when she crossed the center line and hit this Ford Taurus head-on.

That violent crash killed the driver... 16-year-old Kaitlyn Hansen, who was a junior at Fillmore Central High School.

Investigators determined that Mueske had a blood alcohol concentration between .08 and .151 percent and was driving between 85 to 95 miles per hour when the crash occurred.

Kaitlyn was an amazing young woman who enjoyed spending time with her family and friends. That was all taken away because of one person's decision to drive drunk.

Today, Kaitlyn continues to impact many lives – she made the choice when she got her driver's license to become an organ donor.

Since her passing, she has given the gift of LIFE to countless people, including a 5-month-old baby girl and a 7-year-old boy. Her family is so proud of her decision to be an organ donor...
