LEGISLATIVE REPORT 2024

Tax Cuts and Reform

- Eliminating all taxes on Social Security for 75% of seniors couples earning less than \$100,000 and single filers under \$78,000
- Tax cuts through increasing the Homestead Credit, Renter's Credit, and Child and Working Family Tax Credit
- Increasing local government and county program aid to keep property taxes down

Local Priorities

- \$5.8 million in aid to local governments in our district
- \$8.1 million to extend the Mill Towns State Trail to Northfield
- \$1.79 million in local nursing home funding in our area
- Over \$1.5 million for our local police departments
- \$300,000 in funding to help build more affordable housing in Northfield
- Investing \$100 million in rural broadband expansion

- · Investing in child care and early learning
- · Capping insulin and epi-pen costs
- Ticket price transparency and eliminating junk fees

Supporting Farmers and Protecting Our Environment


- \$300,000 in tree planting grants for Northfield to address emerald ash borer
